## Trip Itinerary July 25-30, 2024

#### Day 1

You'll be met at Palmerola International Airport (XPL) by Olancho Aid staff and taken to a nearby restaurant for lunch before going to the hotel in Juticalpa (approx 4 hour drive).

#### Day 2

Hot breakfast is served at the hotel each morning. Then spend Day 2 at Nazareth School to visit with students, meet principal Gloria, and learn about the development of the vocational water filtration and art programs.

#### Day 3

Work alongside staff, students and family members as they spread out across Juticalpa during the annual Nazareth Collection. We'll seek donations from local leaders, businesses, schools, and community members.

#### Day 4

Enjoy Mass at the Cathedral in the center of Juticalpa, then experience culture and culinary specialties in the afternoon with local friends of Olancho Aid.

#### Day 5

Join students in their classrooms and support a service activity at the school.

#### Day 6

We'll depart from the hotel early to return to XPL for flights home.

# How do I reserve my spot?

## How do I get there?

Travelers are responsible for booking their round trip flights to and from Palmerola International Airport (XPL). Ideally travelers will arrive before 2pm on the 25th and depart after 12pm on the 30th. If you are considering a flight scheduled at another time, please contact us before making the flight purchase.

Travelers stay in a local hotel. Sheets, towels, and a pillow are provided. Hot water and air conditioning are \*usually\* available. WIFI will be available sporadically throughout the trip.

## Where will we eat? What if I have a food allergy?

Travelers will sample culinary specialties of Juticalpa. Meals may be enjoyed at the hotel, as a picnic, in a restaurant, or even in the home of a community member. Vegetarian meals can be accommodated if requested in advance. Those with food allergies or other restrictions should discuss them with us before the trip to determine the type of accommodations that can be made.
